The following rules apply to the use of the Association pool(s). Additional rules may be posted at the pool:

- 1. ALL RESIDENTS AND GUESTS 14 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED AT ALL TIMES BY A MEMBER/HOMEOWNER 18 YEARS OR OLDER OR A CHILDCARE PROVIDER 18 YEARS OR OLDER WHO HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BY THE MEMBER/HOMEOWNER IN WRITING IN ORDER TO BE ADMITTED TO THE POOL AREA.
- 2. Non-swimmers and/or non-competent swimmers must be accompanied at all times within arm's reach by a responsible parent, guardian or adult who is a competent swimmer and is taking direct responsibility for them. Member/Homeowners and their guests must always be diligent and vigilant in supervising and watching their children in the Pool area. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK at all times.
- 3. A swimmer using the Pool must take a cleansing shower before entering the Pool enclosure. A swimmer leaving the Pool to use the restroom must take a second cleansing shower before returning to the Pool enclosure.
- 4. Any child under three years old, any child not toilet trained, and any person who lacks control of defecation shall wear a water resistant swim diaper and waterproof swim wear. Swim diapers and waterproof swim wear shall have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference. Regular diapers are not permitted in the Pool.
- 5. Diapers shall be changed only in restrooms or changing stations and shall not be changed at pool side. The person or persons who change the diaper must wash their hands thoroughly with soap before returning to the Pool. The diapered person must take a cleansing shower before returning to the Pool.
- 6. Pool users are required to wear appropriate swimwear at all times. No street clothing such as undergarments, sports bras, basketball shorts, jean shorts or cargo shorts are allowed. White t-shirts or tank tops are permitted over an appropriate swimsuit. Association Pool Monitors shall make the final determination if swimwear is disallowed in the Pool area. Nudity is strictly prohibited.
- 7. The Pool operating hours are 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM, Monday thru Saturday and 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM on Sundays. The lap swim lanes are open exclusively for lap swimmers from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM daily. The Pool will generally open on Memorial Day and close Labor Day based on Board of Director approval.
- 8. Pool deck perimeter is reserved exclusively for walking, safety and emergency purposes. No obstruction of any kind is permitted in the perimeter area.
- 9. Conduct by any person deemed to be dangerous, unreasonable, or offensive (including "horseplay") is not allowed.

- 10. Any individual disciplined repeatedly, incur serious infractions, or knowingly be deceptive when filling out the liability or tenant forms, may lose Pool privileges for the rest of the season.
- 11. No screaming or other boisterous behavior will be permitted in the Pool area. No profane, discriminatory, or other language unacceptable to reasonable members of a civil society or garments displaying such language are allowed.
- 12. Under no circumstances shall bicycles, skateboards, scooters, or motorized cycles be permitted within the fenced Pool area. Roller skates and/or rollerblades may be carried into the Pool area and stored with personal belongings but may not be worn nor used within the fenced Pool area.
- 13. No animals are allowed in the Pool area at any time except for registered service or approved assistance animals.
- 14. Diving from the side of the Pool is not permitted.
- 15. Running, hopping, or skipping within the Pool area is prohibited. Do not throw items.
- 16. Climbing or sliding on any hand railing is not permitted.
- 17. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PROHIBITED.
- 18. NO GLASS CONTAINERS of any type are allowed in the Pool area.
- 19. Smoking and vaping are prohibited in the Pool area.
- 20. No trash, rocks, cans, bottles, food, or other such items may be thrown, placed, or discarded into or around the Pool area.
- 21. Food shall only be consumed in areas of at least ten (10) feet away from the Pool. No ceramic, china, glass or other breakable containers are allowed. Trash containers will be available and Facility Users must clean-up after themselves. Chewing gum is not allowed within the Pool area. All trash must be placed in garbage containers or otherwise properly disposed of.
- 22. Chairs, coolers, or other such items may not be placed in such a manner that would obstruct movement around the Pool area. Individuals should not sit or lie in areas that would impede movement around the Pool area.
- 23. Persons with open sores, wounds, and bandages or communicable diseases, ear or nasal discharge are not allowed into the Pool area. Association Pool Monitors will make the determination as whether a swimmer is disallowed into the Pool area.

- 24. IF A FECAL ACCIDENT OCCURS, all swimmers must exit the Pool immediately, and the Pool will be closed for a minimum of six to eight (6-8) hours to be treated chemically. If a Pool user is found to be responsible for a closure due to a fecal incident, all costs to clean and reopen the Pool may be assigned to the Member/Homeowner.
- 25. Flotation devices are permitted only under the following conditions:
 - a. Only circular and infant inflatables are permitted
 - b. Circular inflatables must be no larger than 42" in diameter
 - c. Circular inflatables must be transparent
 - d. Mesh infant inflatables must be no larger than 33' x 38"
 - e. Pool noodles are permitted
 - f. Water wings without attached chest piece are prohibited
 - g. Pool mattresses are prohibited.

For safety reasons and at the discretion of the Association Pool Monitors, they have the right to ask Pool users to remove flotation devices at any time. Pool users are encouraged to bring Coast Guard approved life jackets to assist non-swimmers.

- 26. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- 27. In the event of thunder and/or lightning, swimmers are to clear the Pool for at least thirty (30) minutes after thunder and/or lightning has ceased.
- 28. All homeowners and guests must obey the Association Pool Monitors.
- 29. The Association Pool Monitors have the authority to remove any violators from the pool area.
- 30. External sound producing equipment is prohibited. Use of personal earphones not emanating external sound are permitted.
- 31. Pool and surrounding deck areas cannot be reserved. All areas are first come first served usage.
- 32. Additional rules may be posted at the Pool.
